PREREQUISITE WORKSHEET - 18-month BSN Program

This worksheet is to help determine which prerequisites you have fulfilled and those which you have remaining to meet the prerequisite coursework for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Program. The following are instructions for completing this guide. Do NOT submit this worksheet in lieu of the application.

1. If your credits are on the quarter system, convert them to semester credits. The formula for this is: quarter credits divided by 1.5 = semester credits. *Example: 4 Quarter Credit Hours = 3 Semester Credit Hours; 6 Quarter Credit Hours = 4 Semester Credit Hours;*
2. If you have not yet completed one or more of the prerequisites, list the course(s) you intend to take and the term the course(s) will be completed in the "To Be Completed" column.
3. All courses listed on the worksheet must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher.
4. The credit hours listed next to each pre-requisite are a minimum requirement and must be met.
5. The number of points received is the number of semester hours multiplied by the grade point received for a class. (A=4.0, A-=3.7, B+=3.3, B=3.0, B-=2.7, C+=2.3, C=2.0) *Example: You receive an "A" which is worth 4 grade points, in a 3 semester credit hours class; You would multiply the number of points received (4) by the number of credit hours (3) which would give you a Points value of 12.*
6. A single course may not be used to satisfy more than one prerequisite area.
7. Your GPA is calculated by using the following formula (total #of points divided by total # of semester hours)
8. This worksheet is for advising purposes only. To be able to provide adequate advising, prospective applicants are asked to submit unofficial transcripts or course descriptions with the prerequisite worksheet.
9. This worksheet will **not** be utilized to determine admission status, nor is it an offer of admission. Completion of all prerequisite courses does not guarantee admission into the program. All other minimum admission requirements must be met to be **considered** for admission. If you are on the quarter credit hours system, you may also need to take Part III if Part I and II do not satisfy a total of 12 quarter credit hours. Must include labs.

MICROBIOLOGY (4 semester hours) - Introduction or General Microbiology. Must include lab(s).

COLLEGE MATH OR HIGHER (3 semester hours) - Courses deemed as remedial will not satisfy this requirement. (Elementary or Intermediate Algebra do NOT meet this requirement; A Statistics math course will NOT meet this requirement.
