

Firearms and Weapons Policy

Roseman University of Health Sciences strictly prohibits the possession or use of firearms and weapons on property owned, utilized, or controlled by the University.

Firearms or weapons includes any device that can expel a projectile, and/ or other dangerous weapons, including knives, explosives, or other items that in their intended use, are capable of inflicting serious injury. Because these items pose a clear risk to the persons and property on the Roseman campuses, violation of this policy may result in suspension, termination or expulsion from the University and removal from the property and criminal or civil prosecution under appropriate city, state, or federal laws, and/ or a fine.

No one except law enforcement officers of either the States of Nevada, Utah or of a Federal Law Enforcement Agency, shall be permitted to possess or carry firearms or other weapons licensed or unlicensed, concealed or not concealed, with or without a concealed weapon permit, while upon properties owned operated, leased, utilized or controlled by the University without specific written permission from the Vice President of Operations.
