

POLICY FOR STUDENT ONLINE PRESENCE

Roseman University of Health Sciences does not host, sponsor, promote, approve or authorize student organization websites, blogs or social media sites, profiles or groups. Student organizations that create external websites, blogs, or social media sites, profiles or groups to promote either their activities, or those relevant to the University must post the following disclaimer:

“The views and opinions of authors and commenters expressed herein do not state or reflect those of Roseman University, its Faculty, Staff, Administration or Board of Trustees. This site is independently run by [insert student organization name] and its content should not be taken as a position or endorsement by the University.”

The disclaimer must be posted on a website or blog so that it is visible on all pages. On social media sites, profiles or groups, the disclaimer must be placed prominently in the “About Us” section. Failure to include the disclaimer by student organizations will result in the loss of status as a Roseman University approved student organization.

All websites, blogs, or social media sites, profiles or groups must comply with the Roseman University of Health Sciences Visual Identity Policy. Student organization websites, blogs or social media sites, profiles or groups are subject to periodic audit by Student Services to ensure compliance as outlined in this policy. Non-compliance will be reported to the appropriate Dean or Program
