

## Coverage of Immunizations

Individuals enrolled in group or individual health plans will have access to the vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) with no co-payments or other cost-sharing requirements when those services are delivered by an in-network provider. ## Immunization Services for Children

Beginning September 23, 2010, children 0 through 18 years that are enrolled in group or individual health plans will be eligible to receive the following vaccines recommended by the ACIP without any cost-sharing requirements when provided by an in-network provider.

- *Haemophilus influenzae* type b
- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Human Papillomavirus vaccine (HPV) – Quadrivalent or Bivalent
- Inactivated Poliovirus
- Influenza
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella (MMRV)
- Meningococcal
- Rotavirus
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella

## Immunization Services for Adults

Beginning September 23, 2010, adults 19 years and older that are enrolled in group or individual health plans will be eligible to receive the following vaccines recommended by the ACIP without any cost-sharing requirements when provided by an in-network provider.

- Hepatitis A
- Hepatitis B
- Herpes Zoster
- Human Papillomavirus vaccine (HPV) – Quadrivalent or Bivalent
- Influenza
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Varicella (MMRV)
- Meningococcal
- Pneumococcal
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap)
- Varicella
