- 3. Demonstrate effective communication skills and strategies across a variety of platforms to communicate relevant medical information to patients, caregivers, and other healthcare professionals (stakeholders).
- 4. Evaluate patient- and population-based needs to promote disease prevention, disease management, and health and wellness.
- 5. Advocate for patient-centered care with consideration of cultural awareness and social determinants of health.
- 6. Identify and implement concepts of storage, packaging, handling, delivery systems, and disposal of pharmaceutical products.
- 7. Demonstrate proper procedures and techniques to fulfil a medication order including: use of equipment for drug preparation, compounding, and administration of hazardous and non-hazardous, sterile and nonsterile products.

- 9. Practice pharmacy ethically while following federal and state laws and regulations.
