NURS 712 - Regional Anesthesia

This course covers the theoretical and clinical aspects of the administration & management of regional anesthesia. Anatomy, physiology and pharmacology will be studied/applied to the administration of anesthetic blocks. Simulation will be used to help learn basic skills. 2 credits didactic. Prerequisite: All Prior Coursework

NURS 713 - Professional Aspects of Anesthesiology Nursing

This course explores: AANA organizational structure, including affiliated councils, codes of ethical conduct and current issues in anesthesiology nursing. 3 credits didactic. Prerequisite: All Year 1 Coursework
