Dr. Jonathan Sherin is a psychiatrist and neurobiologist with decades of leadership in public service and mental health systems. He most recently served as Director of the Los Angeles County Department of Mental Health, the largest public mental health system in the United States, and has also held roles as Chief of Mental Health in the Department of Veterans Affairs and as a nonprofit executive at both local and national levels.

A champion of community-driven transformation, Dr. Sherin is known for his “heart-forward” leadership and commitment to elevating the voices of individuals, families, and communities. His work focuses on advancing equitable, effective systems of care through initiatives that humanize services, align resources with community needs, and address complex mental health challenges. He is also a dedicated advocate for Veterans, particularly in addressing moral injury and its impact on well-being.

In addition to his leadership, Dr. Sherin is an accomplished scientist recognized for identifying the brain’s “sleep switch,” with research featured in *Science*. He serves as Professor and Vice Chair of Psychiatry and Biobehavioral Sciences at UCLA and holds faculty appointments at USC and Roseman University College of Medicine. We are honored to welcome Dr. Sherin as the keynote speaker for our White Coat Ceremony, where his commitment to compassionate care and system transformation reflects the values we strive to instill in our future physicians.
