

**FULL-TIME STUDENT DEFINITION POLICY**

*Approved by Administrative Council 2/08/2016; Updated 11/25/2019*

*Effective date 12/01/2019*

**College of Pharmacy and College of Dental Medicine:** Roseman University recognizes students enrolled in eight (8) credit hours during a financial aid payment period as a minimum full-time course load.

**MBA Program:** Roseman University recognizes students enrolled in twelve (12) credit hours over the course of the regular academic year (not including summer courses) as a minimum full-time course load.

**College of Nursing:** Roseman University recognizes undergraduate students in the College of Nursing enrolled in twelve (12) credit hours during a financial aid payment period as a minimum full-time course load.

Roseman University recognizes students in the Master of Science in Nursing/Family Nurse Practitioner (MSN/FNP) degree enrolled in six (6) credit hours during a financial aid payment period as a minimum full-time course load.
